Woking Borough Council has launched a **HANDYMAN** services called Homelink that can offer to do minor repairs or adaptations in client's homes. Our service is available to anyone aged 60 or over or if they are disabled.

Homelink can arrange for Minor repairs and adaptations, safety advice and work such as securing rugs and carpets and trailing wires, and small electrical and plumbing jobs.
